

# GLHQ BOM

## Block # 7

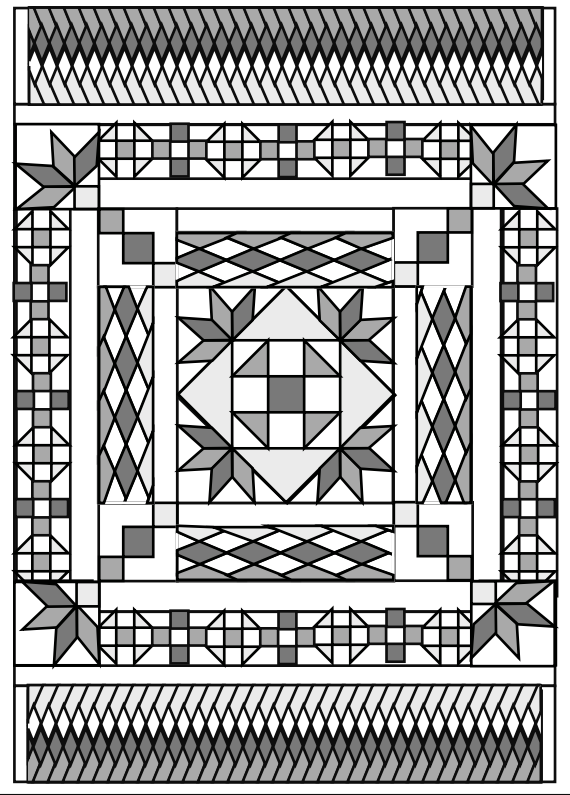
This month we will make four half star blocks. with a square in the corner. You can choose to piece the block or applique it.

### To applique:

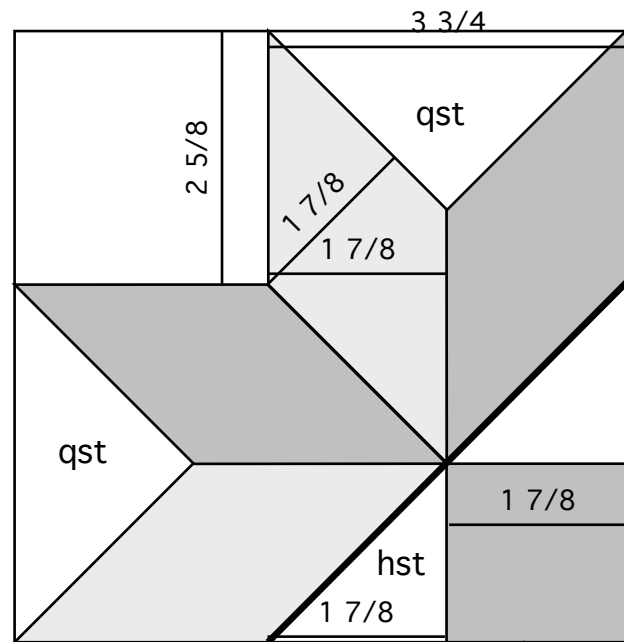
Cut four 6-7/8" squares from the background fabric, then cut diagonally. These are slightly oversized so that you can trim to size when finished.

Cut 16 diamonds at 2-3/8". You can use one fabric, two fabrics, or four fabrics for the diamonds. Sew four diamonds together, turn raw edges then applique onto background triangles with your favorite technique.

Cut four 2-3/8" squares from an accent fabric and applique onto corner of block under half star.



\*\*\*\*\* The measurements on this diagram are finished dimensions. The cutting instructions include seam allowances.\*\*\*\*\*

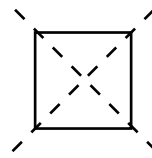


### To piece:

From background fabric



Cut 4 squares at 3-1/8" for corners



Cut 2 squares at 5" then cut into qst's.



Cut 4 squares at 2-1/2" then cut into hst's.

Tip: Cut background pieces slightly larger so you can trim back to final size



From accent fabrics, cut a total of 16 2-3/8" diamonds

Cut four squares at 2-3/8" for corner square.

Trim block to 6-7/8" square.
