Seminole Piecing

Cut **four** strips from the full width of each of your fabrics as follows:

 4.75"

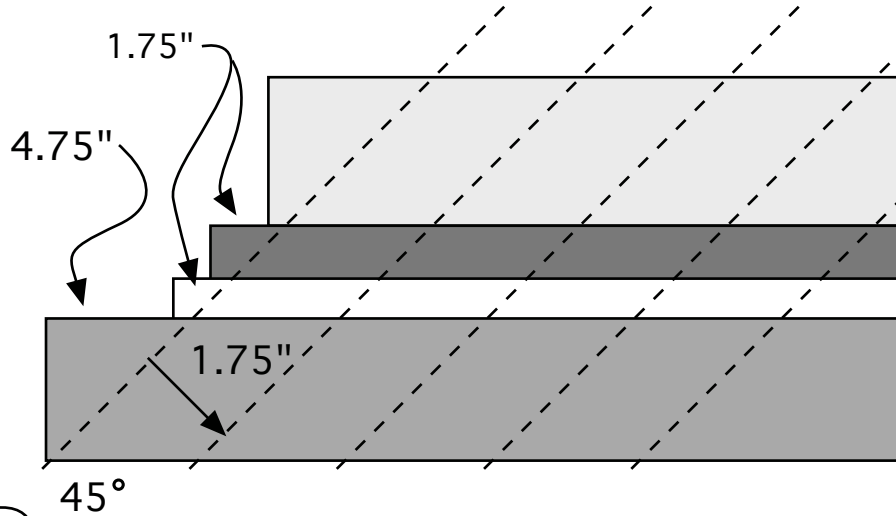
 1.75"

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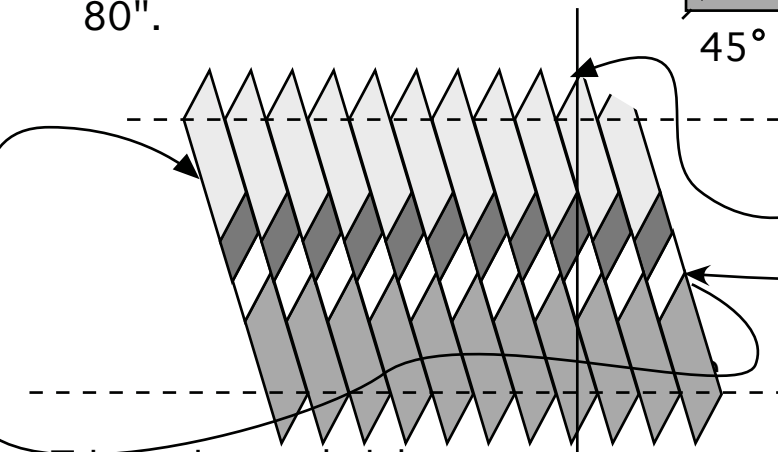
 4.75"

Make 4 strip sets, sewing them together as shown below, staggering them for most efficient use of fabric.

Cut each strip set on a 45° angle, 1.75" sections.



1 Arrange strips as below and sew all of them together into one long strip. About 80".



2 Make a vertical, straight cut through the strip.

3 Take this edge and match it up with the other edge and sew together.

4 Trim strip to a height of 8.5", centering pattern.

5 Cut this strip into two equal pieces. They will measure approximately 40" and be narrower than the center of the quilt top that you have already built. Use background fabric to make fillers for the sides of these strips.
