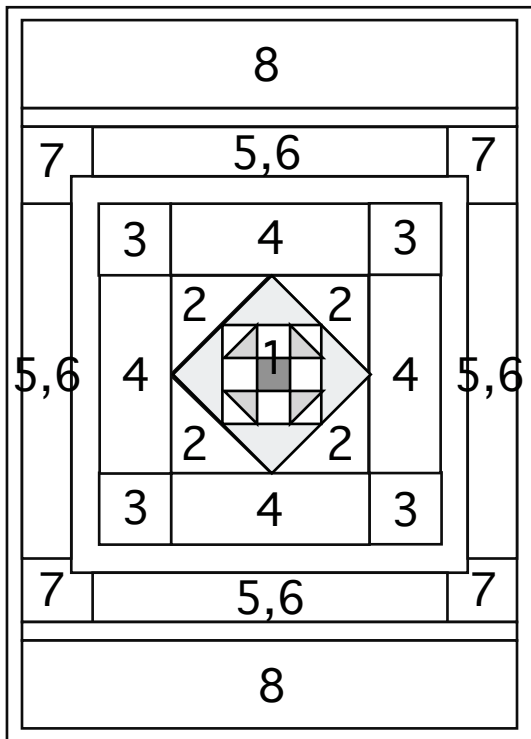


GLHQ 2012 Block of the Month



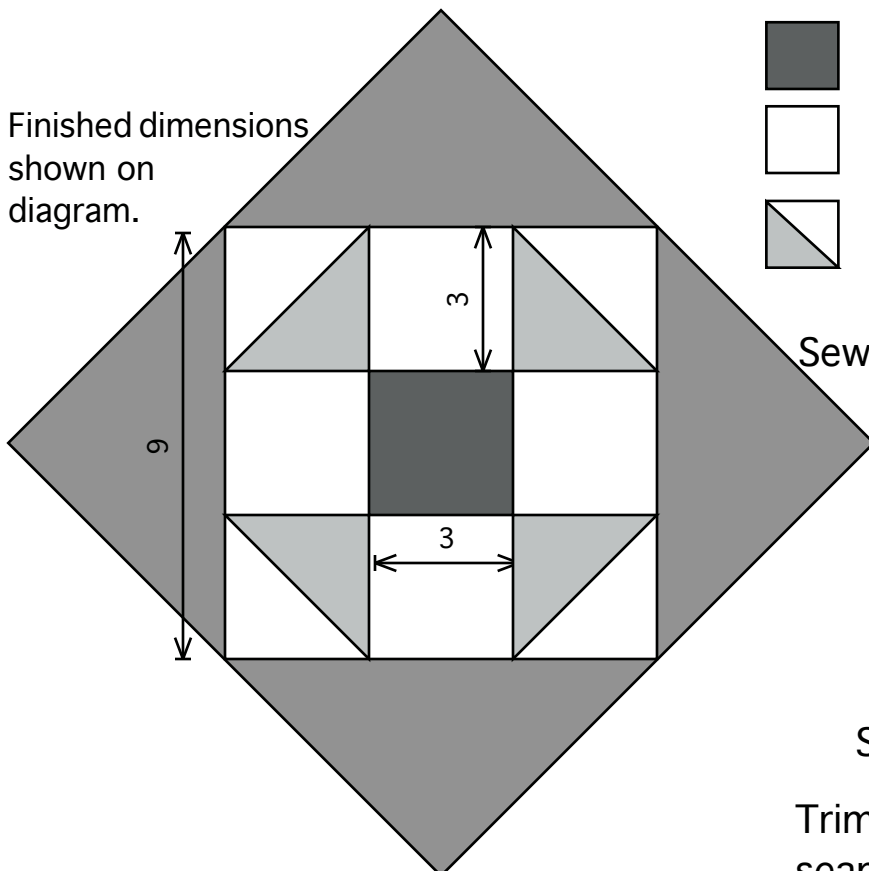
This quilt will be built over eight months. Each month, you will be given another piece of the quilt. For standard quilt blocks you will be given finished dimensions for the block components, but minimal instruction for making them. Use your favorite method for making things like half square triangles, nine patches, etc. or look it up in your favorite quilting book. Finished quilt size will be approximately 45" by 66".

Fabric - You will need about
 2.5 yards of background fabric and
 1 yard, at least, of each of at least four different fabrics, fat quarters will make some things more difficult than they need to be




If you want to keep it simple, I recommend that you avoid large prints and choose a very light or very dark background for best contrast.

As you go forward, you may find opportunities to use additional fabric choices or add in your own details.

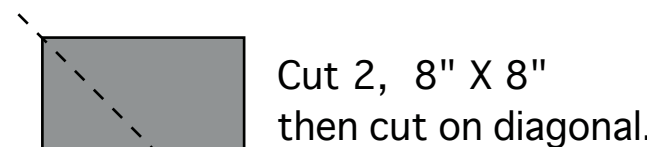
October - Block # 1



Finished dimensions shown on diagram.

-  cut 1, 3.5" X 3.5"
-  cut 4, 3.5" X 3.5" (background)
-  in addition, make 4 hst's, 3.5" X 3.5"

Sew these together to make 9.5" X 9.5" block, this includes seam allowances.



Sew bias edge to 9.5" block.

Trim block to 13.25 ". This includes seam allowances.
